How to get to Trondheim?

Trondheim airport Værnes has direct flights to most cities in Norway and to Copenhagen and Stockholm

Suggested flights to Trondheim the 11th:

Direct from Copenhagen

SAS: SK2880 Copenhagen 08:40-Trondheim 10:15 Norwegian: DY903, Copenhagen 09:25-Trondheim 10:50

Direct from Stockholm

SAS: SK1485 Arlanda/Stockholm 10:30-Trondheim 11:40

From Gothenburg

SAS: SK150 G **Gothenburg 08:25** Arlanda/Stockholm **09:25** , then SK1485 10:30 to Trondheim or

SAS SK1439 Gothenburg 06:35 Copenhagen 07:25, then SK 2880 08:40 or DY903 09:25 to Trondheim

From Helsinki

Helsinki- Stockholm/Arlanda (many flights) and then SAS: SK1485 Arlanda 10:30-Trondheim 11:40 Blue One KF639: Helsinki 06:40 Copenhagen 07:25, then SK 2880 08:40 or DY903 09:25 to Trondheim

There is frequent flights to Trondheim from most domestic airports

Return November the 12th:

Most of you may depart form Værnes to Oslo with DY 761 (Norwegian) 15.00 or SK 365 (SAS) 15.30. There will be connecting flight in Oslo to most domestic and international destination

!NB be quick to book flights for two reasons:

Many of you will arrive trough Copenhagen the 11th: Norwegian and SAS have both just opened new direct flights from Copenhagen to Trondheim and they both offer cheap seats right now.

Most of you will depart from Trondheim the 12th with D Y 761 (15:00) or SK 365 (15:30). Make sure that you have a reservation
